Making the Most of Your Fundraising Event

1. Set a Fundraising Goal

Having a target can motivate both you and your supporters. Whether it's £50 or £500, every little bit makes a difference!

2. Make It Easy to Donate

- Use collection tins or a donation box at your event.
- Set up an online fundraising page and share it with friends and family: www.justgiving.com/campaign/rbcbigbake.
- Encourage contactless donations if possible.

3. Promote Your Event

- Spread the word on social media using #RBCBigBake.
- Share photos and updates leading up to and during your event.
- Ask your workplace, school, or community centre to help promote it.

4. Encourage Friendly Competition

- Host a baking contest for "Best Cake," "Most Creative Bake," or "Best Decoration."
- Charge an entry fee for participants and let attendees vote for their favourites.

5. Offer Extras to Boost Donations

- Organise a raffle with prizes donated by local businesses.
- Run a guess the weight of the cake game.
- Sell recipe books or baking kits with a portion of proceeds going to the charity.

6. Corporate Matching & Sponsorship

Ask your employer if they offer matched funding for charity events. See if local businesses would sponsor your event by donating ingredients or prizes.

7. Sell Pre-Made Treats

If some guests can't attend, offer pre-made treats for sale before or after the event. Fun Themed Bake Sale Ideas:

- The Great Bake-Off: Challenge guests to bake their best treat and crown a champion!
- Afternoon Tea: Pair cakes with tea and ask for a suggested donation.
- Cupcake Decorating Station: Let guests decorate their own cupcakes for a fee.
- Retro Bakes: Encourage participants to bake classic or vintage recipes.
- International Flavours: Celebrate different cultures by featuring bakes from around the world.

Classic Victoria Sponge Cake

Ingredients:

• 200g caster sugar

• 200g unsalted butter, softened

• 4 large eggs

• 200g self-raising flour

1 tsp baking powder

• 2 tbsp milk

• 200ml double cream

• 100g strawberry jam

• Icing sugar (for dusting)



Method:

- Preheat oven to 180°C (160°C fan)
- Grease two 20cm cake tins
- · Cream together butter and sugar until light and fluffy
- Beat in the eggs one at a time
- Fold in the flour and baking powder
- Add milk
- Divide the mixture between the tins
- Bake for 20-25 minutes
- Once cooled, spread jam and whipped cream between the layers
- Dust with icing sugar and serve!



Chocolate Fudge Brownies

Ingredients:

- 200g dark chocolate
- 150g unsalted butter
- 250g caster sugar
- 3 large eggs
- 100g plain flour
- 30g cocoa powder
- 1 tsp vanilla extract



Method:


- Preheat oven to 180°C (160°C fan)
- Line a 20cm square baking tin
- Melt chocolate and butter together over a low heat
- Stir in sugar, then beat in eggs one at a time
- Fold in flour, cocoa powder, and vanilla extract
- Pour mixture into tin and bake for 25-30 minutes



Lemon Drizzle Cake

Ingredients:

- 200g unsalted butter, softened
- 200g caster sugar
- 4 large eggs
- 200g self-raising flour
- Zest of 2 lemons
- 100ml lemon juice
- 100g icing sugar



Method:

- Preheat oven to 180°C (160°C fan) and grease a loaf tin
- Cream butter and sugar until fluffy
- Add eggs one at a time, mixing well
- Fold in flour and lemon zest
- Pour into tin and bake for 40-45 minutes
- Mix lemon juice and icing sugar to make drizzle
- Pour over cake while warm and allow to soak in
